
The History

WHY THE NAME THE APOTHECARY? We wanted to honour the history of the building by the name 'The Apothecary'. For 75 years the Douglas family served the Islands with their Pharmacy & Chemist before finally closing their doors in October 2024.

Previous to the Douglas family's chemist it was "The First and Last Shop'. Due to the perfect harbour side location of the building, this is the place where tourists flock for their souvenirs and their wellness products before they board and come off the Scillonian.

We chose the name 'The Apothecary' to continue the legacy of the building contributing towards the wellbeing of the Islands. I am really excited to promote powerful benefits of art on our physical and mental health, as well as selling goods that contribute towards our wellbeing, in this historic building.

And what is most meaningful to us, my husband Rich worked here from November 2003-April 2025. This was his first job when he moved permanently to the Islands.
